COMMUNICATION PROTOCOLS IN THE EVENT OF A POLLUTION INCIDENT AT LIPA PHARMACEUTICALS

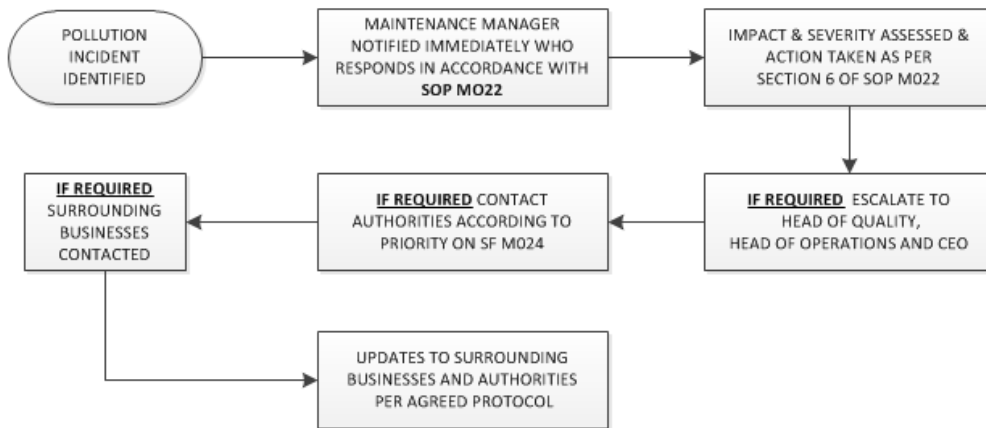

As such, we are licensed by the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) to manufacture products under Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP). The TGA regulations are considered to be amongst the strictest in the world in regards to materials handling and tracking, which means the practices currently employed by Lipa, are best in class globally.

With regards to potential incidents, Lipa takes its environmental responsibilities seriously and fully complies with the Protection of the Environment Operations Act (1997) in addition to the 2012 amendments, requiring that we hold a detailed response and mitigation plan for all materials contained onsite.

After a thorough audit of our practices and materials, Lipa has identified the only real risk is the spill of liquid during the delivery process. The materials that could be spilt are varied, but are consumed on a daily basis by most consumers in healthcare products, and are considered safe for consumption.

Based on this, only immediate neighbouring businesses and authorities will be contacted as required by the matrix below.

The suitable contact details and priority for communication is shown in other parts of the plan, but for privacy reasons, are not published here.



Note:

The Maintenance Manager is responsible for activating the Incident Response Plan and escalating as necessary. In the event that an environmental incident at Lipa requires the authorities to be alerted, the communication with the relevant authorities will be conducted by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and all correspondence should be directed to him.

Given the nature of the potential incident, all communications would be through phone calls and/or face to face meetings with the necessary authorities and surrounding businesses.
